Interstate 35 reopened after 18-wheeler crash

7:42 p.m. update: Interstate 35 has been reopened following a crash near Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.

Earlier: A multi-vehicle crash involving two 18-wheelers has reduced Interstate 35 south at Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to one lane, according to police.

The crash happened about after 6 p.m. in the the 1700 block of the interstate on the upper deck, police said.

One person was taken to University Medical Center Brackenridge with serious injuries and a mother and baby were taken to the hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Police are still investigating the scene and have not released a cause or how many vehicles were involved.

Afternoon commuters should expect delays.
